Conditions of Application

(A) Application/Renewal of Airfield Vehicle Permit (AVP)

- All applicants who wish to apply/renew their permits are required to submit their application forms (Application for Airfield Vehicle Permit) to the Airside Driving Centre. Incomplete applications will be rejected. Applicant will have to resubmit a full application. Rejected applications will not be returned.
- 2. Renewal applications are to be submitted withing 3 months prior to AVP expiry date.
- Please include the following submissions:
 - · Registration of New Vehicle form (for new vehicles only)
 - Completed Application Form for Airfield Vehicle Permit
 - THE VEHICLE (4 VIEWS: FRONT, SIDES AND BACK) refer to part (B) for more information. Coloured photos only.
 - . Certificate of insurance or endorsement letter covering Airside of Changi Airport (AVP will be issued according to expiry of insurance or max 1 year)
 - Vehicle log card or equipment specification for non-LTA registered vehicle
 - Inspection certificate issued by vehicle inspection service provider licensed by Land Transport Authority of Singapore and CAG Airfield Inspection Certificate. Certificate is valid for three (3) months from date of inspection.
 - Obstacle light specifications refer to part (C) for more information
 - Tenancy Agreement, if you are parking in the airside when the vehicle or equipment is not in use
 - . MOM LM certificate & operator's license for scissorslift, boomlift and crane
 - CAAS height restriction approval letter for lifting cranes (if applicable)
 - Commissioning Certificate in line with SAOM/JIG (for new CHIPS & JAS bowsers and dispensers only)
 - Declaration form in line with SAOM/JIG (for CHIPS & JAS bowsers and dispensers only) Renewal only
 - · Functionality or preventive maintenance checklist for Ground Support Equipment Renewal only

(B) Vehicle Markings

- Please ensure the vehicles adhere to the following:
 - Entire body of the vehicle down to the waist and front portion of the vehicle shall be painted white, except for operational vehicles belonging to government agencies
 - Vehicles belonging to CAG Airport Emergency Service Division shall be marked with the distinctive colour of the Airport Emergency Service Division
 - · Horizontal surface of the vehicle body to reflect the company's name at the lower half of the body
 - . For construction vehicles, the body colour need not be white If there is a checkered flag (red and white) displayed at the highest point of the vehicle

(C) Vehicle Lightings

1. All vehicles are required to install a low-intensity, Type C obstacle light on the highest point of the vehicle. Kindly refer to the table for the obstacle light specifications

- (a) 360° horizontal. For flashing lights, the intensity is read into effective intensity, as determined in accordance with Aerodrome Design Manual (Doc 9157), Part 4.
- (b) Between 2 and 10° vertical. Elevation vertical angles are referenced to the horizontal when the light is leveled.
- (c) Peak intensity should be located at approximately 2.5° vertical
- (d) Beam spread is defined as the angle between the horizontal plane and the directions for which the intensity exceeds that mentioned in the "intensity" column. (Extracted from Manual of Aerodrome Standards)
- 2. The obstacle light shall be **switched ON** at all times when it is in operation.

(D) Others

- 1. All vehicles unless exempted by CAG shall be installed with seat belts for the driver and the front seat passenger. Every driver and front seat passenger in the vehicle shall fasten their seat belts when the vehicle is in motion
- 2. A "No Smoking" sign must be displayed in a position which is visible to all occupants of the vehicle
- 3. All vehicles unless exempted by CAG shall be installed with reverse sensors at the rear and camera covering the frontage of the vehicle
- 4. Vehicles/equipment must be equipped with fire extinguisher with rating not less than 21B (rating prescription according to SS EN 3-7). Air-tugs must be equipped with fire extinguishers notless than 21B and capacity of not less than 6.8kg. The fire extinguishers must always be serviceable throughout the validity of the AVP
- 5. A decal containing AES hotline must be displayed in a position which is visible to all occupants of the vehicle.

(E) Charges

- Successful applications will be notified via mobile message service WhatsApp.
- 2. Charges for Airfield Vehicle Permit are as follows:

- 3. Payment will be made via link provided, by MasterCard/VISA only.
- 4. Upon successful payment, the image of the permit will be sent via WhatsApp within seven (7) working days.
- All charges are subject to 8% GST.
- 6. Fees paid are not refundable.


(F) Indemnity


